RESOLUTION NO. 20-21

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR THE DIRECTOR OF SERVICE AND SAFETY TO FILE AN APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF OHIO BUREAU OF WORKERS COMPENSATION FOR TRANSITIONAL WORK GRANT PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City desires to make an application to the Ohio Bureau of Workers Compensation (BWC) for a grant of up to \$5,200 from the BWC transitional work grant program for the development of a customized program to assist the City in transitioning injured employees back to work; and

WHEREAS, this matter constitutes an emergency as a timely application will increase the likelihood of an award at the earliest possible date and such an award and resulting creation of a transition program shall benefit the health, safety and welfare of the City of Jackson and its citizens; and, therefore:


Section One. The Mayor, or his duly authorized representative, is hereby authorized to make application to the Ohio Bureau of Workers Compensation for up to \$5,200 from the BWC transitional work grant program.

Section Two. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, and for the reasons set forth above. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Three. In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
