**RESOLUTION NO. 39-21**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION BY THE CITY OF JACKSON TO THE JACKSON COUNTY COMMUNITY FOUNDATION AND THE FOUNDATION FOR APPALACHIAN OHIO FOR A GRANT OF UP TO \$10,000 TO BE USED FOR PROJECTS TO INCREASE THE QUALITY OF LIFE IN JACKSON AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City desires to make application to the Jackson County Community Foundation (JCCF), in partnership with the Foundation for Appalachian Ohio (FAO) for a grant of up to \$10,000.00 to be used for programs or projects to increase the quality of life, create access to opportunities, or implement solutions to a need within the City of Jackson; and

**Section 1.** The Mayor, or his duly authorized representative, is hereby authorized to make application to the JCCF and FAO for a grant in an amount up to \$10,000.00 to be used for the above mentioned purposes.

**Section 2.** This matter constitutes an emergency necessary to further and protect the health, safety and welfare of the City as there is an application deadline of October 12, 2021.

In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
