RESOLUTION NO. 41-21

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE CONVEYANCE OF A 2022 TRAILER FROM THE JACKSON COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY FOR USE BY THE JACKSON FIRE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Emergency Management Agency has offered to the City of Jackson a 2022 6x10 trailer for use by the Jackson Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the offered trailer will be beneficial to the City and will serve a municipal purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson does agree to accept the trailer and that this matter constitutes an emergency as the ownership of the trailer and the ability to take immediate possession and to insure it, is necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO, HEREBY AUTHORIZES SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE THOSE DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO ACCEPT OWNERSHIP OF THE 6x10 TRAILER AND TO CAUSE IT TO BE LISTED AS PROPERTY OF THE CITY FOR INSURANCE PURPOSES AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and the deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
