## RESOLUTION NO. 43-21

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF SAFETY AND SERVICE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE PURCHASE FROM MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS OF RADIOS AND EQUIPMENT FOR USE BY THE CITY OF JACKSON POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR A PRICE NOT TO EXCEED \$117,592.52 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City is in need of new radios and related equipment necessary to provide police protection for the City, and

WHEREAS, the City has adopted legislation to participate in the State of Ohio purchase contract program administered by the Ohio Department of Administrative Services, and

WHEREAS, the City has researched the purchase of radios and related equipment under the State Purchasing Program in accordance with R.C. Chapter 125 and has found the best price to be from Motorola Solutions in an amount not to exceed \$117,592.52, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to R.C. Chapter 125, a political subdivision may purchase supplies as a participant in the State Purchasing Program exempt from any competitive selection procedures otherwise required by law, and

WHEREAS, this matter constitutes an emergency in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the City that the City Police Department be provided the necessary radio equipment at the earliest date possible; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** The legislative authority of the City of Jackson hereby authorizes the Director of Service and Public Safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio to enter an agreement with Motorola Solutions for purchase of radios and related equipment for an amount not to exceed \$117,592.52.

**Section 2.** This matter is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio, for the reasons set forth herein.

In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that the deliberations of the council and any of its committees resulted in such formal action, wherein meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
