**RESOLUTION NO.05-23**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF JACKSON OR HIS DESIGNEE TO FILE AN APPLICATION FOR AN OHIO EPA EQUIPMENT GRANT TO BE USED BY THE CITY FOR PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT TO BE USED FOR LEAK DETECTION AND METER ACCURACY TESTING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, there are funds that may be available through the Ohio EPA Equipment Grant for use in purchasing equipment to be used by the City for leak detection and meter accuracy testing; and

WHEREAS, this matter constitutes an emergency as the application must be filed no later than January 25, 2023 and the award of additional funds is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety or welfare of the City; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the legislative authority of the City of Jackson, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor of the City of Jackson or his designated agent be and is hereby authorized to apply for the Ohio EPA Equipment Grant for use in purchasing equipment to be used by the City for leak detection and meter accuracy testing.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio, for the reasons set forth above. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

SECTION 3. In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
