RESOLUTION NO. 07-23

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO FILE AN APPLICATION WITH THE OHIO VALLEY REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION FOR TRANSPORTATION FUNDING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City now desires to make application to the Ohio Valley Regional Development Commission (OVRDC) for transportation funding for the Beaver Pike Resurfacing Project; and

WHEREAS, the funding requires a local match of \$99,267.92 which has been certified as available by the City Auditor;

WHEREAS, this matter constitutes an emergency for the reasons an immediate and timely filed application will improve the possibility of obtaining the desired funding and to permit the project to proceed at the earliest possible time; and

NOW, THEREFORE:

Section One. The Mayor of the City of Jackson is hereby authorized to apply to the ORVDC for the transportation funding.

Section Two. The City's Auditor, being the chief financial officer, has certified the availability of the required matching funds on or before the dates listed in the project schedule in the amount of \$99,267.92.

Section Three. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, and for the reasons set forth above. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Four. In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Five. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
