RESOLUTION NO. 23-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO TO ACCEPT THE BID OF MCKEE PAVING & SEALING, LLC, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,178,835.75, PLUS AN AMOUNT OF UP TO 30% OF ADDITIONAL QUANTITIES AT THE BID PRICES, FOR THE 2023 CITY OF JACKSON STREET PAVING PROGRAM AS IT WAS THE LOWEST AND BEST RESPONSIVE BID SUBMITTED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in response to a request for bids for the 2023 Street Paving Program project, bids have been reviewed and a determination has been made as to the lowest and best responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the lowest and best responsive bid was from MCKEE PAVING & SEALING, LLC, for a cost not to exceed \$1,178,835.75, plus an amount of up to 30% of additional quantities at the bid prices as set forth in the bid documents based upon unit pricing; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The legislative authority of the City of Jackson hereby authorizes the Mayor or his designee to accept the bid submitted by McKee Paving & Sealing, LLC, of Nelsonville, Ohio, for an amount not to exceed \$1,178,835.75, plus an amount of up to 30% of additional quantities at the bid prices as set forth in the bid documents based upon unit pricing.

Section 2. In order that the project may be completed timely and for the bid amount and at the earliest possible date, as the street paving project is an important program to repair and maintain City streets, this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution necessary to maintain the public health, safety and welfare of the City. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section 3. In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that the deliberations of the council and any of its committees resulted in such formal action, wherein meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
