

BIOSOLIDS REMOVAL PROGRAM:

The City of Jackson land applies all biosolids treated by the Wastewater Plant (WWTP) located at 225 Wood Avenue, Jackson, Ohio.

Biosolids are the settled material generated from the waste stream and are digested aerobically. This is the natural breakdown of Biosolids in a controlled environment to allowing naturally accruing bacteria to reduce the organic material in the biosolids.

The WWTP produces a Class B Biosolids meeting the management practices in 40 CFR 503.14, the site restriction in 503.32 (b) (5), the vector attraction 503.33 (b) 4 and 7, and the pathogen requirement in 503.32 (b) - Alternative #1(1) and #2(1, 2, 3).

Both liquid biosolids and dry biosolids are land applied to fields following proper submission of data sheets and soil testing results, along with final approval granted by the Ohio EPA.
