## ORDINANCE NO. 91-09

AN ORDINANCE FINDING THE LOWEST RESPONSIBLE AND RESPONSIVE BID, AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR THE GENERAL TRADES AND ELECTRIC TRADES PORTION OF THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT SLUDGE DEWATERING IMPROVEMENTS TO DOLL LAYMAN, INC., 4195 GIBSON DRIVE, TIPP CITY, OHIO 45371, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

**Section One.** Council finds that Doll Layman, Inc., 4195 Gibson Drive, Tipp City, Ohio 45371, is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the contract for the General Trades and Electric Trades portion of Water Treatment Plant Sludge Dewatering Improvements Project. This contract has been lawfully advertised and bid, and the lowest responsive and responsible bid is in the total amount of One Million Five Hundred Sixty Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$1,560,000.00), being One Million Three Hundred Forty Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$1,340,000.00) for the General Trades, and Two Hundred Twenty Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$220,000.00) for the Electrical Trades. This contract shall be paid from line item 409-7510-53064: Water Plant Dewatering Project Fund: Project Expense.

**Section Two.** The Mayor or the Service Director is hereby authorized to execute this Contract and any financing documents according to the terms of the lowest responsive and responsible bid.


**Section Three.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to accept this bid as soon as possible to receive the bid price, and in order to commence with this project as soon as possible to meet pending timelines. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

**Section Four.** In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

**Section Five.**

This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.


