ORDINANCE NO. 08-15

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS IN THE WATER FUND: TRANSFER OUT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. *Recreation*

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section 1: The prior appropriations regarding the fund set forth below is hereby modified so as to appropriate additional money as follows:

<u>FUND</u>	<u>CATEGORY</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>
760-7320-53008	Recreation Fund: Maintenance of Equipment & Facilities	\$25,000.00
761-7320-56001	Recreation Reserve Fund: Transfer Out	\$25,000.00


Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance so that the funds can be appropriated in the to make the transfer from Fund #761 to Fund #760 and to appropriate these funds in Fund #760 once transferred.

Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section 3. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
