ORDINANCE NO. 59-18

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY AUDITOR TO POST REIMBURSEMENTS FROM THE ELECTRIC FUND (LAND & IMPROVEMENTS) TO THE CEMETERY FUND FOR THE USE OF REAL PROPERTY BY THE ELECTRIC DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section 1. The legislative authority of the City of Jackson hereby authorizes the City Auditor to make six annual reimbursements commencing in 2018 for \$60,000.00 / year from the Electric Fund to the Cemetery Fund. This reimbursement is for six acres to be used for an electric substation project. The reimbursement is to be made from the Electric Fund (731-7555-54001 Land and Land Improvements) to the appropriate Cemetery Fund revenue line item (Fund # 221).

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio so that the reimbursement can be made and the funds can be used immediately as needed for the City cemetery. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section 3. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
