ORDINANCE NO. 24-20

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS IN THE CEMETERY: STREETS, HIGHWAYS AND SIDEWALKS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section 1: The following appropriations are necessary as follows:

221-7215-54004	CEMETERY FUND: STREETS HIGHWAYS & SIDEWALKS	\$20,452.09

Section 2. These funds were carried over into the 2020 Cemetery Fund to continue with the on-going paving project for the Fairmont Cemetery roads. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary to maintain the public health, safety and welfare as the additional appropriations are needed to continue the paving project and to obtain the earliest paving date with the paving contractor. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section 3. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
