ORDINANCE NO. 20-21

AN ORDINANCE TO MOVE APPROPRIATIONS WITHIN THE WATER FUND FOR ENGINEERING EXPENSES FOR UPCOMING PROJECTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section 1: The following appropriations must be moved as follows:

FROM

701-7510-54002	Equipment	\$40,000.00
701-7510-54003	Buildings & Other Structures	\$35,000.00

TO

701-7510-53007	Professional Services	\$75,000.00

Section 2. This is to move appropriations within the Water Fund to pay for engineering expenses for upcoming projects. This is an emergency so that the appropriations are in place to cover expenditures in a timely manner without causing delay to the projects of the Water Department and is necessary to maintain the public health, safety and welfare. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section 3. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
