ORDINANCE NO. 26- 21

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING THE CITY OF JACKSON'S CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 941.03 FOR EXTRA CEMETERY LABOR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of the City of Jackson has published certain general and permanent ordinances in a volume of Codified Ordinances including section 941.03 that governs extra cemetery labor; and

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of the City of Jackson has enacted Ordinance 25-21, to be codified as section 147.13 in the Codified Ordinance of the City of Jackson that otherwise provides for seasonal employees; and

WHEREAS, this matter constitutes an emergency that requires immediate action to protect the health, safety and welfare of the City of Jackson so as to prevent Jackson City Code section 941.03 from conflicting with the terms the City's seasonal employees ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO THAT THIS MATTER CONSTITUTES AN EMERGENCY FOR THE REASONS SET FORTH ABOVE AND THAT SECTION 941.03 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES IS REPEALED IN ITS ENTIRETY AS SET FORTH BELOW WITH THOSE STRUCK THROUGH PORTIONS BEING REMOVED AND THAT IT BE REMOVED FROM THE JACKSON CITY CODE.

~~During mowing season, which shall be determined by the Service Safety Director, or his designee, extra labor help shall be allowed and those laborers shall be paid at such prices per hour or per day at rates that shall as may be fixed by the Director of Public Service and Safety Council. Extra labor between mowing seasons shall be used on a temporary basis, for opening and closing graves or for other emergencies. The existence of an emergency condition shall be determined by the Service Safety Director, or his designee. Payment for extra labor shall be made upon the order of the Service Safety Director, or his designee, out of the Cemetery Fund.~~

In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and the deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
