ORDINANCE NO. 08-23

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND AMENDING THE CITY OF JACKSON'S CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 147.13 REGARDING SEASONAL EMPLOYEES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of the City of Jackson has published certain general and permanent ordinances in a volume of Codified Ordinances including section 147.13; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the wages established for seasonal employees are insufficient to allow the City to fulfill its labor needs; and

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of the City of Jackson has determined it necessary to amend section 147.13 of the Codified Ordinances to increase the wages as shown below:

147.13 SEASONAL EMPLOYEES.

The Service-Safety Director may hire seasonal employees as the Director determines necessary. The Director shall determine the wages to be paid to seasonal employees but said wages shall not exceed ~~150%~~ 200% of the State minimum wage at the time of employment and such employees shall not be entitled to health insurance or any other City benefits other than those required by Ohio or Federal law. Seasonal employees shall not work more than 29 hours per week and no more than 19 weeks in one calendar year. Seasonal Employees shall serve at the pleasure of the Director.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO THAT SECTION 147.13 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF JACKSON BE REPEALED AND AMENDED REGARDING SEASONAL EMPLOYEES, AS SET FORTH HEREIN, WITH THE STRUCK THROUGH PORTIONS BEING REMOVED AND REPLACED WITH THE UNDERLINED LANGUAGE SHOWING THE AMENDMENTS TO THE ORIGINAL LANGUAGE AND THAT IT BE REPLACED WITHIN THE JACKSON CITY CODE, IN REGULAR TEXT.

Section 1. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, and safety of the city of Jackson, Ohio as the Ordinance must be in effect at the time of advertising, interviewing, and hiring for the new positions. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor as provided in the Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section 2. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be

deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and the deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
