ORDINANCE NO. 15-23

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND AMENDING THE CITY OF JACKSON'S CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 178.04 REGARDING MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF THE DAVID BROOKS JONES ENDOWMENT FOR THE ARTS FUND.

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of the City of Jackson has published certain general and permanent ordinances in a volume of Codified Ordinances including section 178.04; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the requirements for those persons eligible to be board members of the David Brooks Jones Endowment for the Arts Fund requires revision; and

WHEREAS, in order to increase the number of persons eligible for board membership, the legislative authority of the City of Jackson has determined it necessary to amend section 178.04 of the Codified Ordinances as follows:

178.04. The David Brooks Jones Endowment for the Arts Board shall be comprised of five members including the Mayor, City Auditor and one member of City Council and two members of the community being ~~citizens of the City of Jackson~~ persons residing within the boundaries of the Jackson City School District chosen for their abilities to advance youth art programs. The two community members shall each serve a three-year term with one member having his/her first term for a period of two years so that the expiration of the terms of the community members shall be staggered.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO THAT SECTION 178.04 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF JACKSON BE REPEALED AND AMENDED REGARDING BOARD MEMBERSHIP, AS SET FORTH HEREIN, WITH THE STRUCK THROUGH PORTIONS BEING REMOVED AND REPLACED WITH THE UNDERLINED LANGUAGE SHOWING THE AMENDMENTS TO THE ORIGINAL LANGUAGE AND THAT IT BE REPLACED WITHIN THE JACKSON CITY CODE, IN REGULAR TEXT.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and the deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
