RESOLUTION NO. 22-06

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OR HIS DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE, TO FILE AN APPLICATION, AND EXECUTE ANY AND ALL AGREEMENTS OR DOCUMENTS, WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR THE COOPERATIVE PUBLIC BOATING FACILITY PROJECT GRANT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City has an opportunity to file for a grant with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for the Cooperative Public Boating Facility Project Grant; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires to proceed with this process.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor, or his designated representative, is hereby authorized to file an application, to execute any and all documents, and enter into any and all necessary agreements with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for the Cooperative Public Boating Facility Project Grant.

Section 2. This Resolution is hereby is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the City of Jackson, and for the further reason that this project is of great benefit to the citizens of the community and it is necessary to authorize the Mayor to take necessary actions in the submission of an application as soon as possible. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section 3. In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section 4. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.
