## RESOLUTION 8-11

A RESOLUTION TO CONTINUE PARTICIPATION IN A MULTI-JURISDICTION HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE JACKSON COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY.

WHEREAS, the current plan exists between the City of Jackson, Ohio and the Board of Commissioners of Jackson County, Ohio; an agreement that the County, through its Emergency Management Agency, shall provide emergency management for the City in conjunction with a countywide coordinated program; and

WHEREAS, mitigation measured for the City and surrounding areas have been analyzed and prioritized; and

WHEREAS, Jackson County stakeholders have reviewed the Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO THAT THIS COUNCIL HEREBY ADOPTS AND PLANS TO IMPLEMENT THE ACTIONS PRESCRIBED IN THE JACKSON COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN WHICH IS ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE DIRECTOR, JACKSON COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY. THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT AT THE EARLIEST TIME PERMITTED BY LAW.
