

## **RESOLUTION NO.13-11**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF JACKSON TO FILE AN APPLICATION WITH FEMA FOR ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT TO SEEK FUNDING TO OFFSET THE COSTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF A PUMPER TRUCK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson desires to purchase a new pumper truck to replace the City Fire Department's current 1984 pumper truck; and

WHEREAS, the there are grant funds that may be available through FEMA Assistance for Firefighters Grant that will pay 95% of the estimated purchase price of \$210,000 so that \$199,500 of the purchase price would be from grant funding with the remaining \$10,500 to be paid by the City; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare that the City be able to replace the current 1984 pumper truck with a new truck and to do so, it must immediately apply for grant funds available from FEMA for that purpose and this matter constitutes an emergency; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the legislative authority of the City of Jackson, Ohio:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> That the Mayor of the City of Jackson or his designated agent be and is hereby authorized to apply for a grant or grants from the Ohio Public Works Commission for the purpose of purchasing a new pumper truck.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
