WHEREAS, The American Legion is a worthy organization deserving of honor and recognition.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Jackson City Council hereby declares the month of March as AMERICAN LEGION month in the City of Section 1. Jackson, and all citizens are encouraged to honor the organization during this time.

This Resolution is hereby is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution necessary for the immediate Section 2. preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the City of Jackson. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number Section 3. of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the Section 4. passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law. -calmen
