RESOLUTION NO. 14-12

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING ASSISTANCE OF JACKSON CITY SCHOOL SUPERINTENDENT AND OHIO SCHOOL FACILITIES COMMISSION TO IDENTIFY CONTRIBUTING FACTORS TO FLOODING AS A RESULT OF THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE CURRENT HIGH SCHOOL FACILITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson, Ohio has experienced increase flooding and there has been questions raised as to whether the current Jackson High School facility has contributed to the flooding; and

WHEREAS, the legislative authority believes that officials with the Jackson City Schools and the Ohio School Facilities Commission may be able to provide information or assistance to determine how, if at all, the Jackson High School facility may contribute to flooding in the City; and


WHEREAS, this matter constitutes an emergency and requires immediate attention to remedy flooding within the City of Jackson and is in the best interest of the City and furthers the interests of the public health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON HEREBY DIRECTS THE CLERK OF THIS COUNCIL TO CAUSE THIS RESOLUTION TO BE DELIVERED TO THE JACKSON CITY SCHOOL ADMINISTRATOR AS A FORMAL REQUEST FOR ASSISTANCE FROM HIS ADMINISTRATION AND TO SEEK THE ASSISTANCE OF THE OHIO SCHOOL FACILITIES COMMISSION TO DETERMINE IF THE CURRENT JACKSON HIGH SCHOOL FACILITY IS CONTRIBUTING TO FLOODING WITHIN THE CITY..


This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio. In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
