RESOLUTION NO 15-13

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF JACKSON TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR APPALACHIAN REGIONAL COMMISSION PROGRAM FUNDING FOR THE MCCARTY LANE AREA SANITARY SEWER IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson needs to make sanitary sewer improvements in the McCarty Lane Area, and

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson does not have the funds available within its budget to finance the project, it is imperative that the city seek funding from outside programs.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jackson, Ohio as follows:

Section 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized to submit an application for \$250,000 in Appalachian Regional Commission grant funding necessary to finance a portion of the project, and

Section 2: This resolution is declared to be an emergency measure for the general health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Jackson; and

Section 3: In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
