RESOLUTION NO. 04-16

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF JACKSON OR HIS DESIGNEE TO APPLY TO THE OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS: BULLETPROOF VEST PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM FOR THE 2016 GRANT FOR POLICE OFFICER VESTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, there may be funds available to the City of Jackson through the Office of Justice Program: Bulletproof Vest Partnership Program for a grant for 50% of the cost of the purchase of bullet proof vests for the City of Jackson Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the funds for the police officers' vests have been made part of the 2016 budget for the City and an award of the grant will allow the City to recover 50% of its costs; and

WHEREAS, the application must be filed immediately to increase the City's chance of obtaining the funds and to meet filing deadlines and the award of grant funds will be beneficial and necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety or welfare of the City; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the legislative authority of the City of Jackson, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor of the City of Jackson or his designated agent is authorized to apply for the Office of Justice Programs: Bulletproof Vest Partnership program and to execute any and all paperwork associated with this grant. This is a 50% matching grant to purchase bullet proof vests for our police department.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

SECTION 3. In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the


