A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF JACKSON OR HIS DESIGNATED AGENT TO FILE FOR AN APPLICATION WITH THE STATE OF OHIO FIRE MARSHAL FOR A GRANT FOR THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT FOR THE JACKSON FIRE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson Fire Department may apply for up to \$100,000 of grant funds from the State of Ohio Fire Marshal for the purchase of equipment;

WHEREAS, the deadline to make an application for grant funds is March 21, 2016 and;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City of Jackson council as follows:

- 1. The City of Jackson council approves the filing of an application for grant funds from the State Fire Marshal;
- 2. That Mayor Randy Heath or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the State Fire Marshal and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for an award of grant funds;
- 3. That this is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as there is a deadline of March 21, 2016, by which to apply. Following appropriate legislative action, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberation of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
