## **RESOLUTION NO.11-17**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF JACKSON TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE JACKSON COUNTY BOARD ON AGING, INC., OWNER OF OUT LOTS 52 AND 53 IN THE CITY OF JACKSON, TO ACQUIRE TITLE TO SAID LOTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Board on Aging, Inc. is the owner of Out Lots 52 and 53 in the City of Jackson, Ohio, further identified as tax parcel number H140020030700; and

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Board on Aging, Inc. desires to convey Out Lots 52 and 53 to the City of Jackson for \$1.00 and immediate action is required to ensure that the City can acquire the lots and that doing so is beneficial to the City and its citizens and is in the interest of the the health, safety and welfare of the City.

BE IT RESOLVED by the legislative authority of the City of Jackson, Ohio:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> That the Mayor of the City of Jackson or his designated agent be and is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Jackson County Board on Aging, Inc. to acquire Out Lots 52 and 53 for the sum of \$1.00.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open

to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
