A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF JACKSON CONCERNING AN APPLICATION TO THE CLEAN OHIO FUND PANO DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Public Works Commission and the Clean Ohio Conservation Fund, administers financial assistance for the protection and restoration of natural areas and the promotion of public access to these areas;

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson supports the efforts of the Ohio Valley Conservation Coalition to acquire property and provide for public access improvements in the area of Eddie Jones Park and trail;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City of Jackson Council as follow:

- 1. The City of Jackson Council hereby declares our support for the OVCC Preserves Improvement and Protection Project, which is being submitted to the Clean Ohio Conservation Fund on behalf of the Ohio Valley Conservation Coalition;
- 2. That this is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as there is a deadline of which to apply. Following appropriate legislative action, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
