RESOLUTION NO. 12-18

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO FILE AN APPLICATION TO THE STATE MUNICIPAL BRIDGE PROGRAM FOR MUNICIPAL BRIDGE FUNDING FOR THE MAIN STREET BRIDGE OVER SALT CREEK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. Project

WHEREAS, the City desires to make an application to the State Municipal Bridge Program for Municipal Bridge funding for a grant of 95% State funds, with 5% for City engineering, to be used for the Main Street Bridge over Salt Creek; and

WHEREAS, the local funding will be paid from line item 228-7625-54003; and

WHEREAS, this matter constitutes an emergency in that immediate application for funds will assure that the most funds are available at the time of application so as to increase the likelihood that funds will be awarded to the City and such an award shall benefit the health, safety and welfare of the City of Jackson and its citizens; and, therefore:

Section One. The Mayor, or his duly authorized representative, is hereby authorized to make application to the State Municipal Bridge Program for Municipal Bridge funding for the maximum funds available to be used for the Main Street Bridge project.

Section Two. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, and for the reason that the application must be made at the earliest possible date. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

<u>Section Three.</u> In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
