RESOLUTION NO. 22-19

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF JACKSON OR HIS DESIGNEE TO APPLY TO THE OFFICE OF THE OHIO ATTORNEY GENERAL FOR A GRANT FOR THE PURCHASE OF BODY ARMOR VESTS FOR THE JACKSON POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, there is up to \$40,000, with a 25% match, available to the City of Jackson from the Ohio Attorney General's Office from a fund created by the Ohio Attorney General and the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation for the purchase of body armor vests for the City of Jackson Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the City is in need of five body armor vests at a cost of \$4,909.03, for which the City's match will be \$1,227.26; and

WHEREAS, the application must be filed immediately to increase the City's chance of obtaining the funds and to meet filing deadline of May 31, 2019, and the request for reimbursement deadline of June 30, 2019, and the award of grant funds for the purchase of the body armor will be beneficial and necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety or welfare of the City; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the legislative authority of the City of Jackson, Ohio:


SECTION 1. That the Mayor of the City of Jackson or his designated agent is authorized to apply to the Ohio Attorney General for the grant funds to be used to purchase body armor vests and to execute those documents or agreements required to give effect to the grant, if awarded, and to make the 25% match as required.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio for the reasons set forth herein. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

SECTION 3. In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.


