RESOLUTION NO. 30-19

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S PROPOSED STATE ROUTE 93 CORRIDOR PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, ODOT has identified a need for improvements to State Route 93 within the City of Jackson and is now in the planning phase of the projects 100500 and 109840; and

WHEREAS, estimated project costs and associated matches by the City, to be paid from the City's 228 account, are:

Project ID 100500 \$935,000 (\$310,000 local match) June 2021
Project ID 109840 \$3,610,000 (\$203,000 local match) June 2022
\$80-\$90K local funds for curbs and handicapped ramps for the project period

WHEREAS, ODOT has requested that the City of Jackson indicate its support of the project in order that ODOT may continue to plan and budget accordingly for the SR 93 Corridor Project; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the legislative authority of the City of Jackson, Ohio:

SECTION 1. This body hereby supports the proposed SR 93 Corridor Project and desires to participate with ODOT in the completion of the project within the City of Jackson.

SECTION 2. ODOT is planning numerous projects and requires to know at the earliest possible date if the City of Jackson intends, at this time, to support the SR 93 Corridor Project and, therefore, this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency resolution necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

SECTION 3. In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the




