RESOLUTION NO. 43-19

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO AND AMERICAN MUNICIPAL POWER, INC., FOR TRAINING SERVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson desires to enter into an agreement with American Municipal Power, Inc. (hereinafter "AMP") for various services and training opportunities; and

WHEREAS, a Schedule to Master Services Agreement for Participation in Safety and Training Programs has been negotiated and the proposed Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the City employees receive appropriate training and there is a deadline of December 13, 2019 by which the executed document is to be returned to AMP so that this constitutes an emergency and this action is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the City.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section One. The Mayor or his Service Director is authorized to enter into the Agreement between the City of Jackson, Ohio, and American Municipal Power, Inc., as attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

<u>Section Two.</u> This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the City of Jackson for the reasons set forth herein. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Three. In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Four. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions, were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
