The following is a <u>RESOLUTION</u> enacted by the <u>City of Jackson</u> of <u>Jackson</u> County, Ohio,

(Motion/Ordinance/Resolution) (Local Public Agency) hereinafter referred to as the Local Public Agency (LPA).

## **SECTION I – Project Description**

WHEREAS, the (LPA/STATE) has determined the need for the described project:

Replace the N. High St. bridge (CR 501 0.73 SFN 4061322) as part of the Municipal Bridge Program.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the <u>City of Jackson of Jackson County</u>, Ohio. (LPA)

### **SECTION II - Consent Statement**

Being in the public interest, the LPA gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project as detailed in the LPA-ODOT-Let Agreement entered into between the parties, if applicable.

### **SECTION III – Cooperation Statement**

The LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the development and construction of the above described project and shall enter into a LPA Federal ODOT Let Project Agreement, if applicable, as well as any other agreements necessary to develop and construct the Project.

The LPA agrees to assume and bear the entire cost of the improvement less the amount of Federal and State Funds set aside by the Director of Transportation for financing the improvement from funds allocated by the Federal Highway Administration.

The LPA further agrees to pay 100% of the cost of those features requested by the LPA which are determined by the State and Federal Highway Administration to by unnecessary for the Project.

The LPA further agrees that change orders and extra work contracts required to fulfill the construction contracts shall be processed as needed. The State shall not approve a change order or extra work contract until it first gives notice, in writing, to the LPA. The LPA shall contribute its share of the cost of these items in accordance with other sections herein.
