RESOLUTION NO. 38-20

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF JACKSON TO ENTER INTO A LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH THE JACKSON BOWHUNTERS, INC., AN OHIO NOT FOR PROFIT CORPORATION, FOR A NON-EXCLUSIVE LICENSE FOR THE USE OF APPROXIMATELY 177 ACRES IN LIBERTY TOWNSHIP, JACKSON COUNTY, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson is the owner of approximately 177 acres in Liberty Township, Jackson County, Ohio in SSR lots 45, 46, 51 and 52 and further described in the License Agreement attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Jackson Bowhunters, Inc (aka Jackson Bowhunters Club). is an Ohio non-profit corporation that is well established in the City and County of Jackson and has shown itself to be uniquely qualified to manage and operate a club for archery activities and to and maintain the real property in a safe and attractive condition and to mow the real property at no additional cost to the City as it has done for many years; and

WHEREAS, the license granted to Jackson Bowhunters, Inc. is non-exclusive and shall not interfere with the City's use of the property; and

WHEREAS, in order for the Jackson Bowhunters, Inc. to operate and maintain the property for archery activities, it requires that it's rights and obligations be continued pursuant to a renewed license agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, this matter constitutes an emergency, as the previous license agreement was for a period of 10 years and expired in August, 2020, so that the Jackson Bowhunters, Inc. can undertake the obligations set forth in the license agreement to continue to operate, insure and maintain the premises.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO THAT THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF JACKSON BE AND IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE THE LICENSE AGREEMENT ATTACHED HERETO AND THAT THIS MATTER CONSTITUTES AN EMERGENCY NECESSARY TO PROTECT THE HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE CITY FOR THE REASONS SET FORTH HEREIN.

In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
