**RESOLUTION 42-20**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF JACKSON TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY ADMINISTRATION TO MAKE AN APPLICATION TO THE FOUNDATION FOR APPALACHIAN OHIO FOR GRANT FUNDS FOR REPAIRS AND DEVELOPMENT TO CITY PARKS AND POOLS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the legislative authority of the City of Jackson authorizes the Administration of the City to apply for grant funds from the Foundation for Appalachian Ohio for use in repair and development of the pool and parks of the City of Jackson; and

**WHEREAS**, this matter constitutes an emergency so that the City may immediately request a share of available funds as a timely application will increase the possibility of the award of grant funds and to do so is necessary to preserve the health, safety and welfare of the City and its citizens.

**WHEREAS**, the City now desires to proceed with the grant applications process.


**Section One.** The Mayor, or his duly authorized representative, is hereby authorized to make application to the Foundation for Appalachian Ohio for grant funds for repairs and development of the pool and parks of the City.

**Section Two.** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, and for the reason set forth above. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

**Section Three.** In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

**Section Four.** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
