RESOLUTION NO. 45-20

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY TO FILE AN APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF OHIO, FIRE MARSHAL FOR FUNDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City desires to make an application to the State Fire Marshal for a grant of funds to be used for the purchase of equipment for use by the Jackson Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, this matter constitutes an emergency as the application may be filed as early as December 16, 2020 and there is an application deadline of January 31, 2021. This matter constitutes an emergency as a timely filing is necessary to be considered for an award of grant funds and such an award shall benefit the health, safety and welfare of the City of Jackson and its citizens; therefore:


Section One. It is hereby RESOLVED, that the Mayor or the Director of Public Service and Safety, is hereby authorized to make application to the State Fire Marshal up to the maximum funds available to be used for the purchase of equipment for the Fire Department.

Section Two. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, and for the reason that the application must be made at the earliest possible date. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Three. In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
