RESOLUTION NO. 30-21

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION BY THE CITY OF JACKSON TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR THE STORYBOOK TRAIL GRANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City desires to make application to the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR), Recreational Trail Program for a grant of up to \$10,000.00 from its Recreational Trail grant program, also referred to as Stroybook Trail program; and

WHEREAS, the City grant application has the support of the Jackson City Library and others and the City now desires to proceed with the grant applications process.

Section 1. The Mayor, or his duly authorized representative, is hereby authorized to make application to ODNR for the Storybook Trail grant in an amount up to \$10,000.00.

Section 2. This matter constitutes an emergency necessary to further and protect the health, safety and welfare of the City as a timely application will increase the likelihood of an award and an award of funds will enable the City to develop a program found by the State of Ohio to promote literacy and a healthy lifestyle.

In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
