**RESOLUTION NO. 47-21**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF JACKSON TO ACCEPT THE 2021 CDBG COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM GRANT FOR FUNDING OF THE MITCHELL STREET SANITARY SEWER PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City has been awarded funding from the CDBG Critical Infrastructure Grant for the Mitchell Street Sanitary Sewer Projects that requires the City to execute the Participation Agreement with the Board of Commissioners of Jackson County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, this matter constitutes an emergency as there is a deadline by which the project must be commenced and completed and use of the funds is necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the City of Jackson and its citizens; and, therefore:

**Section One.** The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the CDBG Critical Infrastructure Grant Participation Agreement and other documents as needed for the completion of the project and as required for the use of the CDBG funds.

**Section Two.** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, and for the reasons set forth above. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

**Section Three.** In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
