RESOLUTION No.53- 21

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF JACKSON TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE U.S. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATION (EDA) ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF JACKSON FOR THE WATER AND WASTEWATER MAIN LINE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT; AND DESIGNATING A DEDICATED REPAYMENT SOURCE FOR THE MATCH AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson seeks to construct the Water and Wastewater Main Line Improvements Project; and

Whereas, the City of Jackson intends to apply for EDA funds for the project; and

WHEREAS, the EDA requires the applicant to pass legislation for application and the execution of an agreement as well as designating a dedicated match source; and

WHEREAS, this matter constitutes an emergency as a timely or early application will increase the opportunity for the City to receive the fund requested. This matter constitutes an emergency so as to increase the likelihood that the grant will be awarded to the City and an award of such a grant shall benefit the health, safety and welfare of the City of Jackson and its citizens; and

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jackson:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor of the City of Jackson be and is hereby authorized to apply for a EDA Grant, sign all documents for and to enter into an agreement for the project.

SECTION 2. That the dedicated match will be Community Improvement funds.

SECTION 3. In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

SECTION 4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the

public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
