RESOLUTION NO. 07-22

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS TO THE COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT BOARD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Board of Commissioners have created a Community Improvements Board; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to R.C. section 307.282, the Mayor of the City of Jackson shall appoint three members, not more than two of who shall be members of the same political party, to serve on the board, subject to approval of this legislative authority, those appointments being: Randy Evans, Brett Reed, and Derek Cales; and

WHEREAS, the appointments are to immediately fill positions on the Community Improvements Board and must be made at the earliest possible date and is necessary for the efficient operation of the Board and is necessary for the health, safety, and welfare of the City of Jackson and constitutes and emergency;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the legislative authority of the City of Jackson, Ohio:

Section 1. That the Mayor of the City of Jackson has appointed Randy Evans, Brett Reed, and Derek Cales to be members of the Community Improvements Board and said appointments are hereby approved by this legislative authority.

Section 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section 3. In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and the deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
