RESOLUTION NO. 13-22

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH S & S ENGINEERS, INC. TO COMPLETE THE ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE MILL STREET WATER PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

WHEREAS, this legislative authority has appropriated funds for the Mill Street Water Project; and

WHEREAS, S & S Engineers, Inc. is qualified to provide the professional engineering services of a specialized nature required for and in furtherance of the Mill Street Water Project as required by the City and is already providing similar service for the City on its Mill Street Sewer Extension Project; and

WHEREAS, the engineering services must be completed at the earliest possible date so as to allow the City to meet project construction timelines required by the City and the completion of the Water Project is necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the City and its citizens;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THIS LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Mayor or his designee is authorized to enter into an agreement with S & S Engineers, Inc. for professional engineering services required for the Mill Street Water Project.

Section 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio for the reasons set forth herein. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section 3. In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
