RESOLUTION NO. 22-22

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO FILE AN APPLICATION FOR THE ARPA FIRST RESPONDER WELLNESS, RECRUITMENT, RETENTION AND RESILIENCY GRANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City desires to make an application to the ARPA First Responder Wellness, Recruitment, Retention and Resiliency Grant for use by the Jackson Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, this matter constitutes an emergency as there is an application deadline of June 17, 2022 by which application must be made to be considered for the funds requested. This matter constitutes an emergency so as to increase the likelihood that funds will be awarded to the City and such an award shall benefit the health, safety and welfare of the City of Jackson and its citizens; and, therefore:

<u>Section One.</u> The Service-Safety Director, or his duly authorized representative, is hereby authorized to make application to the ARPA First Responder Wellness, Recruitment, Retention and Resiliency Grant for the maximum funds available.

Section Two. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, and for the reason that the application must be made at the earliest possible date to increase the likelihood of an award and to meet the application deadline. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

<u>Section Three.</u> In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
