**RESOLUTION 33-22**

**RESOLUTION ACCEPTING TENTATIVE AGREEMENT REGARDING THE  
NEGOTIATIONS BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSON, JACKSON COUNTY,  
OHIO AND AFSCME, OHIO COUNCIL 8, AFL-CIO, LOCAL 3619  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

BY THE COUNCIL:

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Chapter 4117 establishes collective bargaining procedures for public employers and public employees; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Chapter 4117, it is the desire of this Council that the Tentative Agreement reached with the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Ohio Council 8, AFL-CIO be accepted by the legislative body.

WHEREAS, This matter is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Jackson as immediate action is required to meet the imposed deadlines for the City's response to meet the current contract expiring deadline. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Jackson, Ohio, that the tentative agreement referenced above is hereby deemed accepted by the legislative body; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this matter constitutes an emergency for the reason set forth above and that the Council's authorized representative(s), are authorized to execute a collective bargaining agreement, in accordance with the terms of said award, on behalf of the Employer.
