RESOLUTION NO. 36-22

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF JACKSON TO FILE AN APPLICATION FOR A GRANT FROM THE FOUNDATION FOR APPALACHIAN OHIO'S COMMUNITY FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Foundation for Appalachian Ohio's Community Fund (FOA) has funds available for projects or programs that increase quality of life, create access to opportunities, or implement a solution to a need within Appalachian communities; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to make an application to the FOA for funds to be used in the City of Jackson and at the City pool for paving of the parking and basketball areas; and

WHEREAS, this matter constitutes an emergency as there is a September 27, 2022, deadline to file, and an award of such a grant will be beneficial to the City and is necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the City of Jackson and its citizens; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. The Service-Safety Director is hereby authorized to submit an application to FOA for a grant of funds to be used as set forth herein and to and to execute all contracts, agreements or other documents necessary for the application, acceptance and implementation of the terms of the grant.

Section Two. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, for the reason that the application must be timely made and that an award of the grant is beneficial and necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the City of Jackson and its citizens. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Three. In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
