RESOLUTION NO. 54-22

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY TO FILE AN APPLICATION WITH THE OHIO BUREAU OF WORKERS COMPENSATION FOR THE SAFETY INTERVENTION GRANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City now desires to make application for the Safety Intervention Grant from the Ohio Bureau of Workers Compensation (BWC); and

WHEREAS, there are grant funds available at 3-1 match for a maximum award of \$40,000 for the City from the BWC;

WHEREAS, this matter constitutes an emergency as the City has an immediate need for the grant funds that can be used for the purchase of a portable traffic safety system and, while there is no deadline for the grant application, an immediate application will increase the likelihood of an award and for the timely purchase of the traffic safety system.

NOW, THEREFORE:


Section One. The Director of Public Service and Safety is hereby authorized to apply for the Safety Intervention Grant from the BWC.

Section Two. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson for the reason set forth above. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Three. In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Four. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
