RESOLUTION NUMBER 09-22

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING MEMBERSHIP OF THE TREE COMMISSION FOR THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson has established a Tree Commission that shall consist of five members, pursuant to City Codified Ordinance 179.01, including the Director of Public Service and Safety, a member of council selected by Council, and three citizens selected by the Mayor and approved by Council; and

WHEREAS, according to the requirements of City Code sec. 179.01, the Mayor has selected Bryn Stepp, Beverly Ondera and Crystal Finch, being three citizens and residents of the City of Jackson and at least one of whom is a member of a political party other than the party of the Mayor, and whose terms are set forth in the membership list attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, this Council, in accordance with City Code sec. 179.01, selects Harold Newkirk as its member representative of the Tree Commission.

WHEREAS, this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution necessary to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the City of Jackson, by protecting sidewalks, utility lines, right of way, and healthy trees. This matter constitutes an emergency as immediate action is needed by the committee to make decisions so to not delay ODOT City construction projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO THAT HAROLD NEWKIRK IS HEREBY SELECTED BY THIS COUNCIL TO SERVE AS THE COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVE TO THE TREE COMMISSION AND THAT THE CITIZEN MEMBERS TO THE JACKSON TREE COMMISSION SELECTED BY THE MAYOR ARE APPROVED AND THE MEMBERS OF THE TREE COMMISSION AND THEIR TERMS SHALL BE AS SET FORTH IN THE MEMBERSHIP LIST ATTACHED HERETO.

<u>Section 1.</u> This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution, necessary to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the City of Jackson for the reasons set forth above. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section 2. In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

<u>Section 3.</u> It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
