RESOLUTION NO. 24-23

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE CONVEYANCE OF AN OUT OF SERVICE AMBULANCE FROM JACKSON COUNTY EMS FOR USE BY THE JACKSON FIRE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Jackson County EMS has offered to the City of Jackson an out of service ambulance, VIN 1GBJG316971245781, for use by the Jackson Fire Department as an on-site command center and to provide refreshment for fire fighters at a scene; and

WHEREAS, the vehicle will be beneficial to the City Fire Department and will serve a municipal purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson does agree to accept the vehicle as offered and that this matter constitutes an emergency as the ownership of the vehicle and the ability to take immediate possession and to insure it, is necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the City.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO, HEREBY AUTHORIZES SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE THOSE DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO ACCEPT OWNERSHIP OF THE VEHICLE DESCRIBED HEREIN AND TO CAUSE IT TO BE LISTED AS PROPERTY OF THE CITY FOR INSURANCE PURPOSES AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.**

This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio for the reasons set forth herein. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and the deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
