RESOLUTION NO. 27-23

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND SAFETY OR HIS DESIGNEE TO FILE AN APPLICATION TO THE CLEAN OHIO GREEN SPACE CONSERVATION PROGRAM FOR A GRANT THROUGH THE CLEAN OHIO FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City now desires to make application for a grant from the Clean Ohio Fund, Clean Ohio Green Space Conservation Program; and

WHEREAS, the City has identified projects that will meet the grant requirements and be beneficial to the City; and

WHEREAS, this matter constitutes an emergency for the reason that the application deadline is August 30th; and

NOW, THEREFORE:

<u>Section One.</u> The Director of Public Service and Safety or his designee is hereby authorized to apply for a grant of funds from the Clean Ohio Fund, Clean Ohio Green Space Conservation Program.

<u>Section Two.</u> This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, and for the reason set forth above. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

<u>Section Three.</u> In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Four. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.23 of the Ohio Revised Code.
