RESOLUTION NO. 60-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF JACKSON TO ENTER THE CDBG CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT WITH JACKSON COUNTY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, there are CDBG funds available for the Clinton-Taft sanitary sewer project that will benefit the City of Jackson; and

WHEREAS, in order for the funds to be used for the Clinton-Taft project, the City must enter into an agreement with Jackson County to participate in the management of the project as outlined therein; and

WHEREAS, this matter constitutes an emergency necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the City immediate action is required so that the project can commence at the earliest possible date and to meet the completion deadline required for the grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON AUTHORIZES THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE EXECUTE THE PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT AS ATTACHED HERETO AND TO EXECUTE OTHER DOCUMENTS AS MAY BE REQUIRED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CDBG CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT WITH JACKSON COUNTY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution necessary to maintain the public health, safety and welfare for the reasons set forth above. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that the deliberations of the council and any of its committees resulted in such formal action, where in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
