## **RESOLUTION NO. 63-23**

A RESOLUTION OF THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO TO ACCEPT THE BID OF SUNBELT SOLOMON, INC., ON A PER UNIT BASIS NOT TO EXCEED THE AMOUNTS SET FORTH IN ITS BID RESPONSE AS IT WAS THE LOWEST AND BEST RESPONSIVE BID SUBMITTED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in response to a request for bids for transformers and other items and materials for the City Electric Department, bids have been reviewed and a determination has been made as to the lowest and best responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the lowest and best responsive bid on a per unit basis was from SUNBELT SOLOMON, INC., at the bid prices as set forth in the bid documents based upon unit pricing; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The legislative authority of the City of Jackson hereby authorizes the Mayor or his designee to accept the bid submitted by Sunbelt Solomon, Inc., of Kansas, at the bid prices as set forth in the bid documents based upon unit pricing.

<u>Section 2.</u> In order to provide the City Electric Department with the materials needed for the operation of the City electric utility timely and for the bid amount, this matter is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution necessary to maintain the public health, safety and welfare of the City. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

<u>Section 3.</u> In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that the deliberations of the council and any of its committees resulted in such formal action, wherein meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
