RESOLUTION NO 06-23

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND ENTER INTO AN OHIO EPA WATER POLLUTION CONTROL LOAN FUND (WPCLF) AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF JACKSON FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE MILL STREET SEWER REPLACEMENT PROJECT, DESIGNATING A DEDICATED REPAYMENT SOURCE FOR THE LOAN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson seeks to complete construction of the Mill Street Sewer Replacement Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson intends to apply for Ohio EPA Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) for the financing needed for the construction of the project; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio EPA requires the government authority pass legislation for application of loans and the execution of agreements as well as designating dedicated repayment sources.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF JACKSON:

SECTION 1. It is necessary to apply for construction financing from the Ohio EPA Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF).

SECTION 2. The Mayor of the City of Jackson be, and is, hereby authorized to request from the Ohio EPA Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) the financing required for the construction of the project.

SECTION 3. The method of repayment of moneys loaned from the Ohio EPA Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) shall be wastewater revenues generated from wastewater customers.

SECTION 4. This matter constitutes an emergency pursuant to O.R.C. 731.30 because the immediate passage of the Resolution is necessary in that the immediate construction of the project at the earliest possible time is necessary in order to protect the health of the inhabitants of the City of Jackson, and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption.

SECTION 5. In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
