RESOLUTION NO. 12-23

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION BY THE CITY OF JACKSON TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR THE NATUREWORKS GRANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City desires to make application to the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) for a grant of all or a portion of the funds available in Jackson County up to the County maximum of \$10,071.00 from its NatureWorks grant program including a 25% match by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires to proceed with the grant application process; and

WHEREAS, this matter constitutes an emergency as there is a June 1, 2023 deadline to apply for the funds and the award of additional funds is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety or welfare of the City; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the legislative authority as follows:


Section One. The Mayor, or his duly authorized representative, is hereby authorized to make application to the ODNR for the NatureWorks grant in an amount up to maximum available funds.

Section Two. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio for the reasons set forth herein. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Three. In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Four. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
